



## **Tax and Donation Information**

The Darfur Dream Team is a dynamic partnership of organizations working together on the Sister Schools Program, an initiative to connect American middle schools, high schools, colleges, and universities with sister schools in the 12 refugee camps in Chad. Principal partners in the Darfur Dream Team are USA for UNHCR, Participant Media, Enough, Facing History and Ourselves, the Education Partnership for Children in Conflict, and i-ACT.

USA for UNHCR, and the Enough Project, in particular will collect and distribute funds for the Darfur Dream Team's Sister School Program as described herein. 90% of all donations will go directly to support the refugee camps school through USA for UNHCR; the remaining 10% will go the Enough Project to support U.S. program activities, including video blogging between U.S. and refugee camp schools, events at U.S. schools, and online communications.

Enough is a project of the Center for American Progress. Donations made to Enough will be processed through the Center for American Progress and will be tax deductible and may be disclosed to the IRS. The Center for American Progress has been incorporated and is operated as a public charity. It has received official IRS recognition of its tax exempt status under sections 501(c)(3) and 501(a)(9)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code. Our federal ID number is 30-0126510.
